



TMU Graduation Requirements

Complete a minimum of 122 semester units of credit.
Complete a minimum of 40 semester units in upper division courses. Includes 300 & 400 level courses.
Satisfy all General Education requirements.
Complete the required curriculum for the chosen major's field(s) of study.
Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.00 (cumulative) in all TMU Courses. *Some majors have different GPA requirements.*
Complete a minimum of 32 semester units at TMU, not including Directed Studies coursework.
A maximum of 12 units can be transferred to complete degree requirements after the last 12 units taken at TMU.
